
design trends in the graphic design industry and how they relate to quilting. You will see examples of work that inspires me and how I use that inspiration to create original work.

If you choose a directional fabric, which I did, you will need additional fabric to work with the movement of the fabric! The following are photos to show.




February 15th Red, pink and orange March 21st, Blue, purple and black

Challenge #1 – Small – Japanese Challenge

Challenge #2 – Large – Medallion Challenge

The challenge is to create a "medallion" Style guilt.

- A medallion quilt has a centred block or panel surrounded by multiple, plain, pieced or appliqued borders.
- No bigger than 90" wide/long no smaller than 45" wide/long.
- Must have a minimum of 4 borders.






Library News
