Color 1 Color 1 needs: one 5" x 15" rectangle AND one 2-7/8" x 11-1/2" strip AND one 2-7/8" x 5-3/4" strip



Color 2 Color 2 needs: one 2-1/2" x 10" strip AND one 2-7/8" x 11-1/2" strip AND one 2-7/8" x 5-3/4" strip



Color 3 Color 3 needs: one 4-1/2" x 18" strip AND two 2-7/8" x 11-1/2" strips
